



Project Name: Latin America Continuous Improvement participatory workshops

January 2018 - March 2019

Objective:

- To generate recommendations for FSC on how to integrate and implement continuous improvement in the FSC system, including:
 - Definition of smallholders and communities
 - Identification of critical criteria for continuous improvement concept
 - Timeframe and stages of a continuous improvement concept
- To identify which services/support smallholders and communities need, especially in the phases before certification, and to identify potential business models

Geography & Unique Needs:

- Eight countries in Latin America: Honduras, Mexico, Chile, Ecuador, Brazil, Guatemala, Peru, and Bolivia
- Conformity with FSC requirements is a challenge for small producers and communities
- FSC certification demands a significant investment by landowners, outweighing the economic benefit
- Challenges to access and remain in FSC certified markets

Activities/Methodology:

 Developed concept note and work plan discussed and agreed regionally

- Led 15 consultation workshops in eight countries, with 210 participants from different types of audiences:
 - Smallholders
 - Smallholders and communities' representatives
 - Communities
 - Standard Development Groups (SDGs)
 - FSC Network Partners

Preliminary Outcomes:

- Generic definition of smallholders and communities is challenging
- Continuous improvement concept alone is insufficient. There needs to be incentive to advance through FSC certification through trainings and technical assistance
- Market access, legal issues, respect for rights of Indigenous Peoples is considered critical
- The most important environmental value identified is water
