Introduction:

We at Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) respect your privacy and want you to understand how we collect, use, and share data about you in compliance with applicable data protection laws in relation to the use of our platform.

This Privacy Statement covers our data collection practices and describes your rights to access, correct, or restrict our use of your personal data.

By using the form 'Change request for FSC risk assessments (CNRAs or NRAs)' (hereinafter 'Form') you agree to the terms of this Privacy Statement.

1. What Information We Collect

In order to detail with your request, we may collect some personal data. The personal data we collect on this Form includes the following:

- Full name (first name, last name)
- Email address
- Belonging to a stakeholder group
- Organization name
- Specific content provided by User which might contain further personal and business data.

2. How We Collect Your Data

You directly provide us with all the data we collect. As user of the Form you are responsible for providing accurate, complete and up-to-date information.

This information includes your full name (first name, last name), email address, the organization you represent (if applicable), and your stakeholder group.

FSC International Center (hereinafter 'FSC IC') is the data controller of your personal data, whereas FSC Global Development GmbH (hereinafter 'FSC GD') as responsible entity for the technical aspects of the webpage is the data processor.

3. How We Use Your Data

We process your personal data for one or several of the following purposes:

- to communicate with you,
- to improve and maintain performance in the FSC Certification Process,
- to improve FSC risk assessments,
- to help us to produce FSC reports,
- to handle complaints or resolve infringements,
- to show impact of FSC,
- to develop market intelligence, or
- as is required by law for safety and integrity.

All the personal data we process is processed by FSC IC, however for the purposes of IT hosting and maintenance this information is located on servers in Strasburg in France and Cologne in Germany.

We will not collect any personal data from you that we do not need to provide and oversee this service of our Platform to you.

4. Who We Share Your Data With

Your personal data will be accessible to the data controller (FSC IC). We will only share your personal data with third parties with whom we have a contractual relationship with in order to pursue our legitimate interest in providing the service of our Platform to you, answering your queries and handling your complaints. This can include:

- Staff or Unit of different entities of the FSC Group¹,
- Staff or Unit of FSC Network Partners² & Certification Bodies³,
- Members of Stakeholder working groups,
- Third Party service providers; Email Service Providers; IT Service Providers,
- Independent experts involved in the risk assessment process.

We will take all reasonable steps, such as including the contractual clauses in our contracts with processors or controllers that would ensure that your personal data is safe and treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Statement.

5. Transfer of Data

The personal data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and processed by a processor based outside of the European Economic Area (EEA). If this happens, we will take steps, such as including contractual clauses into our contracts with such processors or controllers, that would ensure that your personal data is safe and treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Statement.

6. How Long We Keep Your Personal Data

Personal data collected for our 'Change request for FSC risk assessments (CNRAs or NRAs)' form will not be stored longer than is necessary in order to achieve the purposes as named within this privacy and cookie statement unless FSC or any of the third-parties engaged by FSC must observe a longer statutory retention period based on a legal obligation. In some cases, we may be legally obliged to keep your data for 10 years.

7. Security

FSC is committed to ensuring the privacy of your personal information. In order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

8. Your Rights

FSC would like to make sure you are fully aware of all your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

- The right to be informed
- The right of access
- The right to rectification
- The right to erasure
- The right to restrict processing
- The right to data portability
- The right to object
- Rights in relation to automated decision making and profiling.

Upon your request, we provide you with information about the personal data we hold about you. You have the right to access or verify your personal data FSC is holding and to have your personal data modified, corrected or deleted under certain conditions at any time. 9. Cookies and Similar Technologies

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit our websites, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

How do we use cookies?

Our use of Cookies automatically gives us certain data, such as IP address, browser used, operating system from your computer and your connection to the Internet.

The information generated by the cookie about your use of our Form (including your anonymized IP address) will be transmitted and stored on our servers in France and Germany. FSC GD will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of our Form, compiling reports on activity and providing other services relating to the Form activity and internet usage.

Unless the law requires so, in no case will the data collected by FSC GD be passed on to third parties or a link with personal data will be established without your consent.

How to manage cookies

You can use our Contact Us online forms without cookies. You can refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings (“do not accept cookies”) on your browser. Please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full functionality of our Form. By using our Form, you consent to the processing of data about you by FSC GD in the manner and for the purposes set above.
