

Can someone steal my crypto from my Ledger? { Yes Crypto Can steal to ledger }

Yes, [+1-888-590-9448](tel:+18885909448) someone **can** steal your crypto from a Ledger if they get the wrong thing or if you make a security mistake, [+1-888-590-9448](tel:+18885909448) but the device itself is designed to make that difficult. How theft usually happens

[+1-888-590-9448](tel:+18885909448) Ledger keeps your private keys offline, so a hacker cannot normally drain your wallet just by attacking the internet. But if someone learns your recovery phrase, they can restore your wallet on another [+1-888-590-9448](tel:+18885909448) device and take the funds. A stolen device alone is usually not enough if your PIN is strong, because repeated wrong attempts can reset the wallet. The real danger comes when users type their seed phrase into a fake website [+1-888-590-9448](tel:+18885909448), approve a malicious transaction, or buy a wallet that was altered before delivery. reddit.com

How to lower the risk

Start by buying only from the official store [+1-888-590-9448](tel:+18885909448) or an authorized seller, not from unknown marketplaces. Set a strong PIN that is hard to guess, and never write it where another person can find it [+1-888-590-9448](tel:+18885909448). Keep the recovery phrase offline on paper or metal, and never store it in screenshots, notes apps, email, or cloud storage. What to do if something looks wrong
