Ledger has officially discontinued the Ledger Nano S. While it may still be available from some third-party retailers while supplies last, it is no longer manufactured or sold directly by Ledger. This retirement marks the end of an era for a device that served as the entry point into crypto self-custody for millions of users.

The Ledger Nano S was first released in 2016 and quickly became a bestseller. It was praised for its compact design, affordability, and robust security, successfully introducing the concept of hardware wallets to a massive mainstream audience. For years, it was the default recommendation for anyone taking their first steps toward securing their cryptocurrency.

However, technological progress and market demands eventually outpaced the aging Nano S. Its primary limitation was a very constrained memory capacity. This hardware restriction meant the device could only hold a limited number of cryptocurrency applications (apps) simultaneously. For a user who wanted to manage Bitcoin, Ethereum, and several ERC-20 tokens, they might have to uninstall one app to install another—a cumbersome process of “app juggling” that created a poor user experience as the crypto ecosystem expanded.

Its retirement was a strategic move by Ledger to streamline its product lineup and focus on more advanced hardware. It has been effectively replaced by two superior devices:

- The Ledger Nano S Plus:** This is the direct and worthy successor to the classic Nano S. Launched as its replacement, the Nano S Plus solves the original’s biggest flaw by offering significantly expanded memory. Users can now manage over 100 apps at once, and it features a larger screen and USB-C connectivity, all while maintaining a very accessible price point. It is the new go-to entry-level device.
- The Ledger Nano X:** Positioned as the premium flagship model, the Nano X builds on the S Plus with the added convenience of **Bluetooth connectivity** for seamless management via the Ledger Live mobile app. It also boasts a larger screen, a longer-lasting battery, and even
